**From Southern/Central California:** Take Interstate 5 North to Yreka. Continue North on Interstate 5 approximately 7 miles and take the Hwy 96 turnoff West to Hamburg and Happy Camp. From the turnoff on Interstate 5 to Happy Camp it is 65 miles.

**MEET: Klamath Inn Motel, Happy Camp, California**  
**Time: 10:00 AM**

ALL passengers should drive to the meeting place on the Happy Camp side of the river about 200 feet downstream from Indian Creek Bridge and Elk Creek Road at the west end of Happy Camp.

**DRIVING INSTRUCTIONS AND INFORMATION**

**From Oregon-CA border:** It is 11 miles to the Hwy 96 turnoff.

**INFO:** All cars will be parked at the ingress point for the duration of the trip. W.E.T. will provide transportation back to your cars.

**NOTE:** *The only gas in Happy Camp is at an automated "card-lock" fueling station that requires the use of a credit card. When coming in to Happy Camp from I-5, Saeid Valley has gas and from east Orleans is the last gas stop. All the stations have limited hours so it is best to top-off before hitting Hwy 97.*

**[WHAT TO WEAR](#) / [WHAT TO BRING](#):** Please dress accordingly. Wetsuits are recommended before June 1 or according to weather. We recommend a farmer john wetsuit w/a paddle jacket (waterproof pullover) and booties. Under your wetsuit, it is advised that you wear a poly-synthetic long sleeve top such as synthetic fleece. **DO NOT WEAR ANY COTTON CLOTHING.** Wear wool or poly-synthetics on your feet with tennis shoes or Teva-type river sandals, cap or visor, sunglasses w/safety strap and **SUNBLOCK!**

**For summer months:** Bathing suit, shorts with tennis shoes or Teva-type sandals. Sunblock, visor, sunglasses w/safety strap.

**For overnight trips** we suggest: tent, dry change of clothes for evening, towel, toiletries, flashlight, rain parka (for inclement weather), sleeping bag, ground cloth, pad and extra money for miscellaneous purchases. 30lbs limit

**KLAMATH INDIAN CEREMONIES:** The Klamath River is a highly regulated river trip under the auspices of the [US Dept of Agriculture & US Forest Service](#). Due to the annual Karuk Indian Ceremonies, many dates may not be available due to our respectful cooperation of the Karuk's ceremonies on this river.

W.E.T. operates under permits issued by the Klamath National Forest. W.E.T. is an equal opportunity service provider.
